- 4 striking "5" and inserting "10".
- 5 SECTION 2. Title 12 Virgin Islands Code, chapter 23, subchapter V, section 1152,
- subsection (a), as amended by Act No. 7705, SECTION 4 (1), is amended by striking "1101 (f)"
- 7 and inserting '1101(i)".
- 8 SECTION 3. Title 12 Virgin Islands Code, chapter 23, subchapter IV, section 1149, as
- 9 added by Act No. 7705, SECTION 2 (c), providing for a January 1, 2025, expiration date for
- 10 customer-generators having a generating capacity greater than 10 Kilowatts residential, is
- 11 repealed.
