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An Act amending title 3, chapter 16, section 273 of the Virgin Islands Code by establishing minimum criteria for Public Services Commission members and changing the number of its members

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Virgin Islands:

- 2 **SECTION 1.** Title 3 Virgin Islands Code, chapter 16, Section 273 (b) is amended
- 3 by: (1) "inserting appointed by the Governor with the advice and consent of the Legislature"
- 4 after "nine members"

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- 5 (2) Striking paragraph (1);
- 6 (3) In paragraph (2):
- 7 (A) striking "Two members of the Legislature appointed by the President,
- 8 one a resident of the District of St. Thomas-St. John, and one a resident of the District
- 9 of St. Croix, who shall serve as nonvoting members. Of the seven members appointed
- by the Governor, three"; and inserting in its place "Four";

1	(B) striking the word "three" where it next appears in the sentence and
2	inserting "four" in its place;
3	(C) after "St. John" inserting an exception clause that reads: "however, a
4	maximum of three board members may reside on the United States mainland
5	Members residing on the United States mainland shall have either been born in the
6	U.S. Virgin Islands or graduated from a U.S. Virgin Islands' high school or the
7	University of the Virgin Islands."
8	SECTION 2. Title Virgin Islands Code, chapter 16, Section 273 (c)is amended by
9	striking "four" and inserting "five" in its place; by striking "appointed by the Governor" and
10	inserting in its place, "with at least one member who is a resident from St Croix"; by inserting
11	a third sentence that reads "Virtual attendance of Commission meetings is allowed, and
12	members attending virtually are included in the quorum count."; and by striking the word
13	"three" and inserting in its place "four of the".
14	SECTION 3. Title 3 Virgin Islands Code, chapter 16, section 273 (f) is amended by
15	striking "\$50" and inserting in its place "\$100"; and by inserting "Members residing on the
16	United States mainland shall attend regular meetings of the Commission virtually" at the end
17	of the section.
18	SECTION 4. Title 3, Chapter 16, Section 273 of the Virgin Islands Code is amended
19	by adding sections as follows:
20	"(h) The Commission may sue and be sued in its own name. The Commission
21	may retain counsel for its representation, notwithstanding Title 3, Section 114 of the Virgin
22	Islands Code.
23	(i) Members of the Commission must have training and experience in at least one
24	of the following categories:

1	(1) Engineering, Power Generation, Energy or Natural Resources
2	Conservation; or
3	(2) Economics, Accounting, or Finance; or
4	(3) Public Administration, Telecommunications, or Law; or
5	(4) Solid Waste Engineering, Solid Waste Management, Water
6	Treatment, or Environmental Protection.
7	(j) (1) No member of the Commission may have any financial interest in, or be
8	an agent or employee of, any public utility, as defined in 30 V.I.C., § 1
9	(2) If any member acquires a financial interest in, or becomes an agent or
10	employee of, any public utility, that member shall cease to be a member of the
11	Commission unless the member, within 60 days of acquiring the financial interest or
12	the position, divests himself of the financial interest or the position.
13	(3) For purposes of this subsection, "financial interest" means financial
14	interest as defined in 3 V.I.C., §1101(1)
15	(k) (1) No member of the Commission may be an immediate family member of a
16	person serving in an executive capacity at a public utility subject to regulation by the
17	Commission.
18	(2) For purposes of this subsection,
19	(A) An immediate family member means a spouse, parent, child,
20	aunt, uncle niece or nephew.
21	(B) A person serving in an executive capacity means a person who
22	holds any of the following titles at a public utility:
23	(i) Chief Executive Officer or Assistant Chief Executive;
24	(ii) Chief Financial Officer or Assistant Chief Financial
25	Officer;

1		(iii)	Chief Operating Officer or Assistant Chief Operating
2	Offic	cer;	
3		(iv)	Executive Director or Assistant Executive Director;
4		(v)	President;
5		(vi)	Vice President; or
6		(vii)	Any other senior management position responsible for
7	strat	egic and	tactical management of any portion of the public utility.
8	(l) (1) No perso	on servin	g in an executive capacity at a public utility may serve as
9	a member of the Commissi	on for at	least two years after leaving employment with the public
10	utility;		
11	(2) No r	nore than	n four members may be from the same political party;
12	(3) No 1	nember	may hold any other public office or an elected office in
13	the local or federal	governm	nent; and
14	(4) (A)	No m	nember may raise funds or solicit contributions for any
15	political candidate	or politica	al party, or actively campaign for any candidate for public
16	office, except that	a mem	ber may actively campaign for an immediate family
17	member.		
18	(B)	The 1	mere attendance of a member at a political event or
19	politically o	riented e	event does not constitute a violation of paragraph (1).
20	(5) No 1	nember i	may enter into an employment relationship, a consulting
21	or representation a	greemen	t, or other similar contract or agreement with either an
22	entity regulated by	the Con	nmission or a subcontractor of the entity for a period of
23	one year after the n	nember c	eases to serve as a member of the Commission."
